Dan grew up in the EMCC, and came to faith in Sunday School at an early age. Kerry did not regularly go to church as a child. Her faith blossomed after her family moved to Canada when she was 13.

Dan trained as a teacher, and Kerry as a business administrator. They married and settled in Alberta in 1996 where they were involved in church ministry for over 13 years. The Wiens began their international work in South Africa in 2010, relocating to the Durban area with their two children, Jeremy and Abigail. Jeremy and Abby are now university students in Canada.

Their time in South Africa has led to a deepening burden to find ways to express the whole gospel message to communities, after seeing first-hand the burden and hopelessness resulting from poverty and hunger. Dan and Kerry are working to develop networks of leaders that will be able to transform the continent. They desire to see people begin to steward Africa's abundance using the Farming God's Way tool. Their work takes them throughout South Africa, Ethiopia and Tanzania.
